

Notes about Photos

Some may not be aware of how to get and save full size versions of the photos. Your mouse may have different settings, however, for me:

- 1) Left button double click gives photo full screen.
- 2) Right button single click calls up menu
- 3) Click Copy
- 4) The image is now on "clipboard"
- 5) Minimize web site (camasrelay)
- 6) Call up whatever photo editing software you have. In my case, Adobe PhotoElements. Following is for that software-yours may be different.
- 7) File
- 8) New
- 9) Image from Clipboard

Now, that image can be edited, printed, or saved.

The photos on web site are compressed to 1,200 pixels wide and 300 pixels per inch and many, if not most, of these are cropped from a larger photo. These web photos represent about 20% of those saved. At season end (at awards) disks of all of the photos will be given away. Typically, I make about 50 copies—some have names on them, plus each coach will get one. If you didn't get a disk—borrow one to copy. This disk will have photos at 2,400 pixels per inch and 300 pixels per inch.

Also, note that I do not go to all of the meets and only those meets I attend will have photos on the disk—this being a volunteer activity for me. If anyone is curious about what I did previously for "work" – go to bottom of main page and click on my aircraft performance link. The "perf" in my email address is first four letters of my job specialty.
